KEY INTERVENTIONS

HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT

| DISTRICT - DHARASHIV

In partnership with Cohesion Foundation Trust, Parivartan is uplifting 12 villages in Tuljapur block, impacting 18,000+ individuals across 4,000+ households.

Key interventions include:

- Organic multiple cropping, Osmanabadi goat & backyard poultry promotion
- Rejuvenating irrigation tanks, percolation trenches, and constructing 14 check dams
- Installing solar streetlights for improved rural connectivity
- Supporting *Tuljai Mahila* Goat and Poultry Producer Co. and exposure visits to model villages

DEVELOPING SOCIO-ECONOMICALLY ROBUST COMMUNITIES

| DISTRICT - YAVATMAL

Parivartan, in collaboration with Sanjeevani Institute for Empowerment and Development (SIED), is driving the socio-economic upliftment of 11 villages in Arni block, benefiting 1,895 farming families by:

- Ensuring irrigation, livestock, and domestic water availability
- Restoring farming as a viable livelihood
- Enhancing sanitation, education, and women's empowerment
- Establishing Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs), market linkages, and enterprises for vulnerable families
- Planting 5,500 trees and installing solar streetlights

COMPREHENSIVE WATER MANAGEMENT

| DISTRICT - BULDHANA

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with Watershed Organisation Trust, is addressing land degradation, water scarcity, and unsustainable farming in 16 villages of Chikhali block. This includes:

- Farm bunding, desilting, and constructing loose boulder and gabion structures
- Promoting vermicomposting, horticulture, and organic practices
- Training *vasudhara sewaks* and *sewikas* for resource efficiency

BUILDING FODDER CAMPS IN DROUGHT-STRICKEN REGIONS

| DISTRICT - PUNE

To combat severe drought in Valha village, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Bharatiya Jain Sanghatana (BJS) launched a fodder camp and cattle shelter initiative, supported by the District Collector & local administration. This includes:

- Setting up cattle shelters with bamboo, pillars and green nets
- Providing large water tanks and cement water pots
- Renting fodder-cutting machines and supplying wet & dry fodder
- Ensuring veterinary health checks and streamlined cattle registration

TRANSFORMING LIVELIHOODS IN DROUGHT-PRONE TRIBAL VILLAGES

| DISTRICT - NASHIK

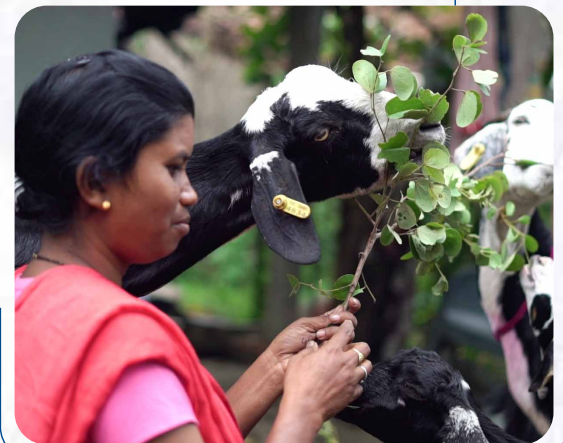
Severe drought in Kalwan block left 70% of the land barren, forcing tribal families into distress migration. HDFC Bank Parivartan and Sanjeevani Institute for Empowerment and Development (SIED) intervened with water conservation structures, drip irrigation, organic farming, solar lighting, and livelihood support through poultry, tailoring, and kitchen gardens. Community training, water user groups, and green initiatives ensured long-term impact. This initiative has restored water security, boosted income, and empowered local communities for a sustainable future.

SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS FOR TRIBAL COMMUNITIES

| DISTRICT - RAIGAD

Economic hardships and limited livelihood opportunities compel many tribal families to migrate to cities in search of work. HDFC Bank Parivartan and EAGL Livelihood Foundation are transforming 27 villages by:

- Training beneficiaries, constructing sheds, and distributing goats
- Providing doorstep animal healthcare and risk management for goat farming
- Pit-digging, plantation drives, and monitoring green cover
- Building 6 farm ponds per village, conserving 5-8 million liters of water

STRENGTHENING COMMUNITIES ENSURING SUSTAINABILITY

| DISTRICT - WARDHA

Rural communities in the region face increasing climate challenges, impacting water access, livelihoods, and education. To address this, HDFC Bank Parivartan and the Aga Khan Agency for Habitat India are empowering 13,114 beneficiaries with sustainable solutions. The initiative focuses on water conservation through check dams, farm ponds, and rainwater harvesting, while upgrading schools with digital tools and eco-friendly infrastructure. It also promotes organic farming with climate-resilient crops, provides livelihood training for women in horticulture, and strengthens governance through Village Development Committees (VDCs). Health camps further support rural well-being with primary care, eye care, and oral hygiene initiatives.

| DISTRICTS - DHARASHIV, SATARA, NASHIK, YAVATMAL, BHANDARA, HINGOLI, NANDED, BULDHANA, PARBHANI, WASHIM

With an aim to improve education for economically underserved students & provide them with a fair opportunity to excel, HDFC Bank Parivartan launched the digital classrooms programme in Maharashtra. With a goal of creating over 100 digital classrooms across various districts, the project will cover over 3,000 students.

INCREASING EMPLOYABILITY WITH TRAINING

| DISTRICT - MUMBAI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and the New Resolution India are working together in Mumbai to provide skill training to youth. Employability training for customer relationship and sales jobs is being provided to people between the ages of 18-25 years from marginal households to assist them with employment in the retail sector and help them make informed decisions. 1,800 individuals are estimated to be impacted by this programme in the span of 3 years.

PRESERVING CULTURAL ARTS WITH TRAINING

| DISTRICT - PALGHAR

In the heart of Jawhar and Mokhada, where tribal artistry runs deep, age-old crafts risk fading into history. To preserve this cultural legacy, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Raah Foundation launched an art-based skill training programme, empowering artisans with contemporary design skills while honoring their traditions. By blending Warli art with sustainable materials like upcycled plastic, textile waste, and grass art, the initiative not only revitalises local crafts but also creates viable livelihoods. Over three years, 1,000 artisans will be trained, equipped for large-scale B2B opportunities, and supported in breaking free from retail market dependency—all while tackling plastic waste.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT THROUGH SKILL TRAINING

| DISTRICTS - MUMBAI, THANE, PUNE

To ensure adequate development of underserved youth and make them capable of earning their livelihoods, HDFC Bank Parivartan, in association with Grey Sim Learning Foundation, launched an intervention to provide skill training and apprenticeship programmes to 700 youth in Vikhroli, Thane, and Shirur in Maharashtra. The project has ensured enrollment of candidates for vocational skills training followed by counselling, classroom training, on-the-job training, external assessments and placements. It will also provide ongoing post-placement support to ensure sustained job success.

IMPROVING STANDARD OF LIVING IN URBAN SLUMS | DISTRICT - MUMBAI

Parivartan, along with the United Way of Mumbai, is implementing a livelihood programme for youth in urban slum communities of Mumbai. The beneficiaries are being provided training in courses like communication, soft skills, basic IT, BFSI, supply chain & logistics, web development and retail for a duration of 2-6 months. Additionally, post-training they are offered placement opportunities. This programme aims to provide independence, education and employment to young people who aren't employed, have dropped out from educational institutions or are on the verge of dropping out.

EMPOWERING YOUTH FOR CAREER GROWTH | DISTRICT - MUMBAI

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with the All India Institute of Local Self-Government (AIILSG), is implementing targeted training programmes to enhance the employability of youth in the Mumbai metropolitan region, with a particular focus on women. The initiative offers specialised courses such as Patient Care Assistance, Child Care, Basic Desktop Publishing (B.DTP), Digital Marketing, General Duty Assistance (GDA), and Social Media Executive training. Each course provides focused, hands-on learning over a period of three months. Over the project duration, the aim is to train more than 1,900 individuals and ensure that at least 70% secure meaningful employment, enabling them to build sustainable livelihoods.

HOLISTICALLY UPSKILLING THE YOUTH | DISTRICT - MUMBAI

Many young people in underserved communities face limited access to education, career opportunities, and personal growth. In response, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Youth For Unity And Voluntary Action (YUVA) have launched an initiative to empower them through skill-building and leadership training. The programme supports 40 youth groups by providing training in well-being, life skills, and, while also fostering engagement through arts and sports. It also establishes 10 community enterprises, offers scholarships, ensures fair job access, and promotes environmental awareness by setting up waste management systems and nature-based safe spaces. This initiative paves the way for a more self-reliant and resilient future.

| DISTRICT - PUNE

To combat high dropout rates and unemployment, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Medhavi Foundation are empowering 3,600 youth across Maharashtra and Gujarat with essential skills. This includes:

- Establishing Centers of Excellence in healthcare, hospitality, apparel, and logistics
- Integrating language proficiency modules and industry visits
- Providing simulated training and continuous technological upgrades
- Tailoring programmes to meet future skill requirements

This initiative aims to bridge the skills gap and facilitate entry into sustainable employment opportunities.

| DISTRICT - MUMBAI

The partnership between HDFC Bank Parivartan and the South Indian Education Society aims to empower women from underserved areas by providing professional training in early childhood education. This initiative will equip 300 women with the necessary skills and certifications to pursue careers as teachers in pre-primary schools in Mumbai. The project focuses on delivering two main courses: a Diploma in Early Childhood Development and a PG Diploma in Early Childhood Development. The initiative is designed to improve the educational landscape by training qualified educators who can make a lasting impact on young children's learning experiences.

BUILDING YOUTH CAREERS AND BREAKING BARRIERS

| DISTRICT - MUMBAI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and United Way of Mumbai aim to transform the lives of 1,500 young individuals from Mumbai's urban slums by equipping them with employable skills. Through targeted training across four trades, supported by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) certifications, the programme strives to ensure 70% of its trainees make informed career choices and secure meaningful employment.

Ratnagiri’s smallholder farmers face income challenges due to traditional farming methods and limited enterprise development. HDFC Bank Parivartan and The PRIDE India are enhancing farmer incomes through education, training, and improved cultivation techniques. Key actions include: promoting cash crops like turmeric and ragi and improving farm produce quality, establishing post-harvest infrastructure and processing units, supporting 125 Farmer Producer Groups (FPGs), and 2 Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) enhancing marketing strategies. This project aims to increase incomes by 35%, strengthen farmer institutions, and ensure food security for 5,000 farming households.

THE CHALLENGE

For Somnath, farming was once a losing battle. Unpredictable rains, degrading soil, and soaring input costs chipped away at both his yield and his confidence. With only a single well to depend on, every crop cycle felt like a gamble. Pests and unstable prices pushed him closer to despair—each harvest bringing more anxiety than assurance.

OUR INTERVENTION

Change came with the Holistic Rural Development Programme (HRDP), supported by HDFC Bank Parivartan and Action For Agricultural Renewal In Maharashtra (AFARM). Though hesitant at first, Somnath took a leap of faith—embracing drip irrigation, mulching, and organic fertilizers. The transition to climate-smart agriculture wasn't easy, but with guidance and training, hope began to take root.

THE RESULT

The results were nothing short of transformative. His pea yield increased by 76%, input costs dropped dramatically, and his profits rose by Rs.2,19,800. But beyond the numbers, Somnath rediscovered his purpose. Today, his journey lights the way for fellow farmers, showing that with knowledge, support, and courage, even the harshest odds can be overcome.

THE CHALLENGE

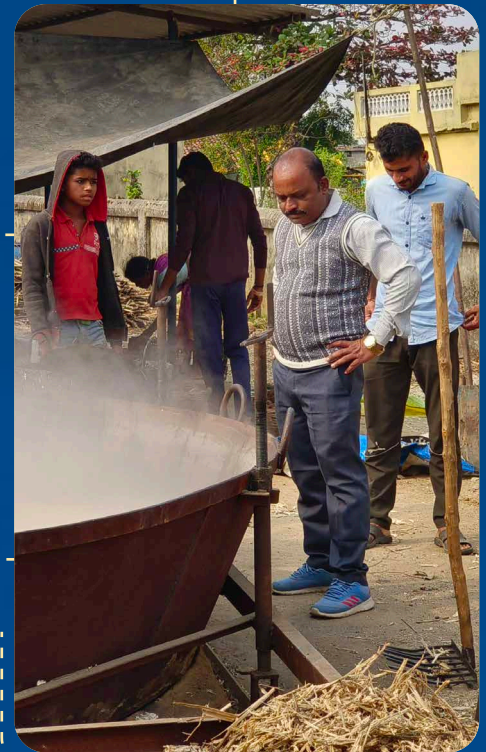
In many rural pockets, life between harvests stretches thin. With agriculture being seasonal, families often face months without income. Droughts, falling prices, and a lack of local opportunities push young people to leave home, chasing uncertain jobs in distant cities. The community spirit weakens, and families are left to struggle alone.

OUR INTERVENTION

Amid this uncertainty, a group of determined youth chose a different path. Seeing the potential in the sugarcane that grew around them, they decided to set up a jaggery processing unit. With support from the Holistic Rural Development Programme (HRDP), backed by HDFC Bank Parivartan and Vikas Sahyog Pratishthan, they received essential equipment, training in hygiene and production, marketing support, and help with formal documentation—turning a simple idea into a sustainable enterprise.

THE RESULT

The unit has done more than generate income—it's revived the local economy. Five families now have stable employment, and 10–12 women earn daily wages. With a turnover of Rs.15 lakh in the past year, the business has become a source of pride. Most importantly, it has brought young people back, restored confidence, and proved that local solutions can change the course of entire communities.

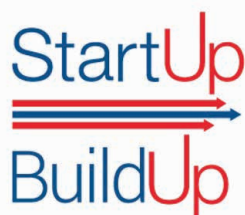

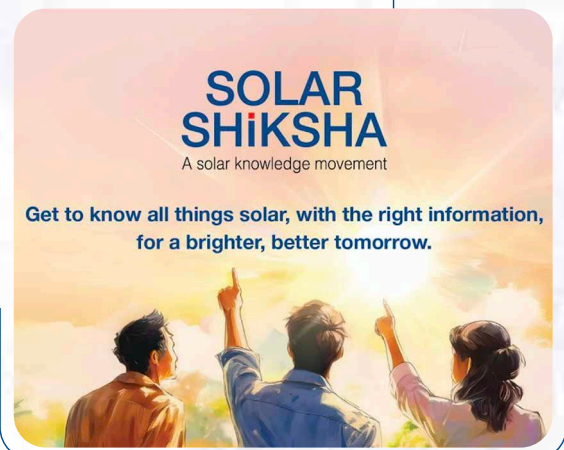
